

Range Rules

General Rules

- Only non-FAC (less than 12ft lbs) air rifles & air pistols can be used on the range.
- You must comply with all firearms laws regarding age & permissions at the range.
- Do not shoot if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medication that may affect your judgement.
- **No** live quarry to be shot at.
- No semi-automatic air rifles, pistols, airsoft or BB guns to be used on the range.
- **NO** 'exploding' or any other additional targets are to be added to the range.
- **NEVER** leave your gun unattended & when not in use, must be unloaded and secured in a cover or carry case.
- Customer's own air cylinders are to be stored under their bench or in their car when not in use.
- All users of the range must sign-in every visit to declare that you are not a prohibited person under the terms of Section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968.
- Any user who wilfully disobeys, violates or does not comply with any of the General or Safety rules will be asked to stop shooting and leave the range.

Safety Rules

- Smoking is not permitted in the firing points.
- Guns must not be removed from their cases or slips until at the firing point.
- Guns must always be pointed in a safe direction.
- Do not shoot at anything other than the designated targets.
- **NEVER** walk on to the range or in to the tunnel when others are shooting.
- Appropriate eye & ear protection must be worn when shooting.
- If access to the targets is required you must consult a member of the range staff.
